# Service changes to the 503 Kingston Rd, 504 King, and 508 Lake Shore streetcar routes for infrastructure renewal

## TTC service changes:

Starting Sunday, May 11, 2025, to Saturday, August 30, 2025 \*Content/timeline accurate at the time of printing

### What's happening at the intersection of King Street East and Church Street?

Starting as early as **May 12, 2025**, the City of Toronto will begin **replacing the aging watermain** at the intersection of King Street East and Church Street.

In **late June 2025**, the City of Toronto and the TTC will **renew the streetcar tracks** at the King Street East and Church Street intersection, requiring a temporary closure.

Later this summer, separate TTC crews will upgrade the **streetcar overhead wiring** along King Street East from Church Street to River Street and Cherry and Sumach Streets.

## Rail delivery and storage

Before streetcar track work commences in late June, the TTC will deliver new streetcar rails on flatbed trailers and store them at or near the work zone. Once details are confirmed, the TTC will notify affected properties.

#### TTC route diversions

During these infrastructure upgrades, the TTC will adjust service on the 503/303 Kingston Rd, 504/304 King, and 508 Lake Shore routes.

#### From May 11 to August 30, 2025:

- 503/303 Kingston Rd, 504/304 King, and 508 Lake Shore streetcars will operate via Queen Street between Broadview Avenue and Spadina Avenue, via Church Street, Adelaide Street / Richmond Street, and York Street.
- 504C King (Bathurst-Distillery) and 504/304D King (Bathurst-Broadview & Gerrard)
   replacement buses will operate on King Street between River Street and Bathurst Street.



From June 22 to August 30, 2025 (once streetcar track renewal starts)

Starting **June 22 until August 30, 2025**, due to the King Street East and Church Street intersection closure, **504C King and 504/304D King replacement buses** will divert around the intersection as follows:

- **Eastbound**: diverting from King Street West and Yonge Street via south on Yonge Street, east on Front Street East, north on Jarvis Street to King Street East to resume regular routing.
- Westbound: diverting from King Street East and Jarvis Street via south on Jarvis Street, west on Front Street East, west on Wellington Street East, north on Yonge Street to King Street West to resume regular routing.
